1 EXT. STRASBURG TRAIN STATION -- MORNING

The Strasburg Rail Road locomotive rolls through the station, steam blowing, the whistle shrieking. The steam engine clears frame, as does the tender. As the train slows, the first passenger car comes to a stop in front of camera, and the HOST steps off the passenger car.

HOST

Welcome to the Strasburg Rail Road, the oldest continuously operating rail road in all of North America. The rail road is a very successful tourism destination here in Lancaster County, PA, and we are very group tour friendly. In this short tape, we're going to try to show you all that the Strasburg Rail Road has to offer your tour customers.

The CAMERA PANS as The Host walks, the steam engine in the background.

HOST (CONT'D) The Strasburg Rail Road is one of the best ways to see pristine Amish farms, farms that have changed little for three centuries. The four mile length of track, stretching from the Strasburg station to Leaman Place, passes through fourteen Amish farms, and includes some of the most (MORE) 1.

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1 CONTINUED:

HOST (CONT'D) breathtaking views of Lancaster County.

(We need to shoot these breathtaking views)

HOST (CONT'D) The ride takes about 45 minutes, with departures on the hour, and a second train added as needed.

In the b.g., a CONDUCTOR calls out.

CONDUCTOR

All aboard!

The Host walks along the train towards the locomotive. We PAN to the engine as she talks.

HOST (V.O.) We have authentic, museum quality, working, turn of the century steam locomotives. You can experience the magic and romance of steam.

Shots of locomotives steaming, rolling, etc.

Shot of modern day people changing to old time people.

HOST (V.O.) (CONT'D) Step back in time by visiting the Strasburg Rail Road.

Back to Host, by the train.

HOST (CONT'D) The Strasburg Rail Road has been featured in a number of movies: Hello Dolly, Thomas and the Magic Railroad, the Wild Wild West, and many more.

2 INT. PASSENGER CAR -- DAY

The Host walking down a non-moving passenger car.

HOST

You can ride in the open or enclosed passenger cars, meticulously restored by our expert shops. These cars, authentic in every detail, down to the coal stoves in the corners, come to us in various stages of neglect, and...

Shot of car changing from stripped to completed.

CONTINUED:

HOST (V.O.) (CONT'D) ... We restore them to their glory. The Strasburg Rail Road is really a rolling museum, offering something for everyone. A great, relaxing ride through Amish farmland, a trip back in time, a train lovers paradise.

Shots of farmland, trains, engines.

3 EXT. PICNIC GROVE -- DAY

The Host gets off the train, picnic basket in hand.

HOST Guests can ride the train to the picnic grove, get off and eat a leisurely lunch, dinner or snack in the middle of the most beautiful farmland on the face of the earth, then hop back on the train when it comes back through.

She sets down a blanket for her picnic. We PAN over to the train leaving, revealing farmland.

4 INT. DINING CAR -- DAY

> The Host walks through the non-moving dining car, with people eating (dressed in period costume)

> > HOST Your quests can even reserve seats on our dining car, and have a relaxed lunch or dinner while riding the rails of the Strasburg Rail Road.

PAN of the dining car.

HOST (CONT'D) The great thing about the Strasburg Rail Road is that you can come for one of our hourly departures, a great way to spice up your touring schedule, or you can come for the entire day.

Various shots of the below as she talks about them (graveyard shot, freight car shots, dining car, etc.).

The Host is standing at the train station, next to the ticket window.

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5 CONTINUED:

HOST

This authentic railroad station, circa 1890, complete with ticket window, waiting room and telegraph office, is where most people start their journey with the Strasburg Rail Road. For groups, however, we offer advance ticket purchase and group discounts.

The Strasburg Train pulls into the station, steaming, bell ringing.

6 EXT. SHOPS -- DAY

The Host walks along the Strasburg promenade, passing and indicating the various shops.

HOST

We have a variety of shops, with everything from clothing, to gifts, to railroad memorabilia, to everything you can imagine from our Thomas the Tank Engine shop.

7 EXT. PICNIC GROVE -- DAY

The Host walks along the track, the beautiful countryside behind her.

HOST Here in Strasburg, the farmland hasn't changed for centuries...
